## HISTORY

This is a continuation of my history story I started in November about the Martinson's 7<sup>th</sup> Addition. It covered 1872 to 1887. Last issue covered 1887 to 1922. Now I will continue from 1922 when the feuding starts.

- 8-31-1922 Others mentioned in the will of Mary E Sankey were her trustees and executors: Frank B. Morris, Arthur Butler Sr. and Irving Crum.
- 12-15-1923 Mr. Morris, Mr. Butler and Mr. Crum and their attorneys: Kos Harris and V. Harris asked the courts for compensation for their services as executors including reasonable attorney fees, and to be discharged as executors of the Estate and wanting to know who were the heirs for the estate. The court allowed the sum of \$2000.00 for the executors and \$1000.00 for the attorneys to be paid out of the proceeds of the real property sold or under contract by heirs.
- 1-24-1924 The heirs: Emma Butler, Robert M. Moore and Mary Nester Moore filed an appeal of the compensation to the executors of the will. They stated they would give a bond of \$500.00 instead and the court approved.
- 2-19-1924 The property was sold to James Wallace and his wife Muriel after they secured a loan from The Wichita Perpetual Building and Loan Association.
- 10-14-1925 The Wallaces paid off the loan
- 2-15-1926 The property was sold to Joy Schuler
- 12-6-1927 The property was sold by Joy and Don Schuler to Mary A. Huffman (a single lady.) Lots of history and stories took place between 1924 and 1941.
- 7-26-1941 Mary Alice Huffman sold to Edna and Joe Logan
- 10-20-1942 Edna and Joe Logan sold the property to E.M and Jessie Alfred Dooley  
The Dooley family history continued until their survivor son Carl Dooley died 4-5-1970.
- 6-8-1971 Dooley estate was sold to Dorothy Gridley, a single woman. She kept the property and married her next door neighbor Dooley Crouch on 9-16-1973. They lived there until they moved to 435 S. St. Clair and rented out the house at 212 S. Athenian.
- 10-31-1986 The little house was torn down and a new house was designed, contracted and built by Dorothy and Dooley at that address.
- 5-15-1987 They moved in and raised their family and remain to this day Dorothy
