If you plan to shoot off fireworks in Wichita this year, you better make sure they're legal and between 10 a.m. to midnight. If not legal you could face a \$250 fine from the city. Fireworks that shoot sparks higher than 6 feet or fireworks that shoot flaming balls are prohibited by the ordinance, which includes fireworks like mortar shells, roman candles and skyrockets.

Fire Department report: The new fireworks ordinance will make it easier for police & firefighters to enforce the law because they will no longer have to see people actually shooting off the illegal fireworks in order to write tickets for it.

You can call **316-290-1011** from 6:30 PM - 3 AM the evenings of July 1st-4th to complain about illegal fireworks."

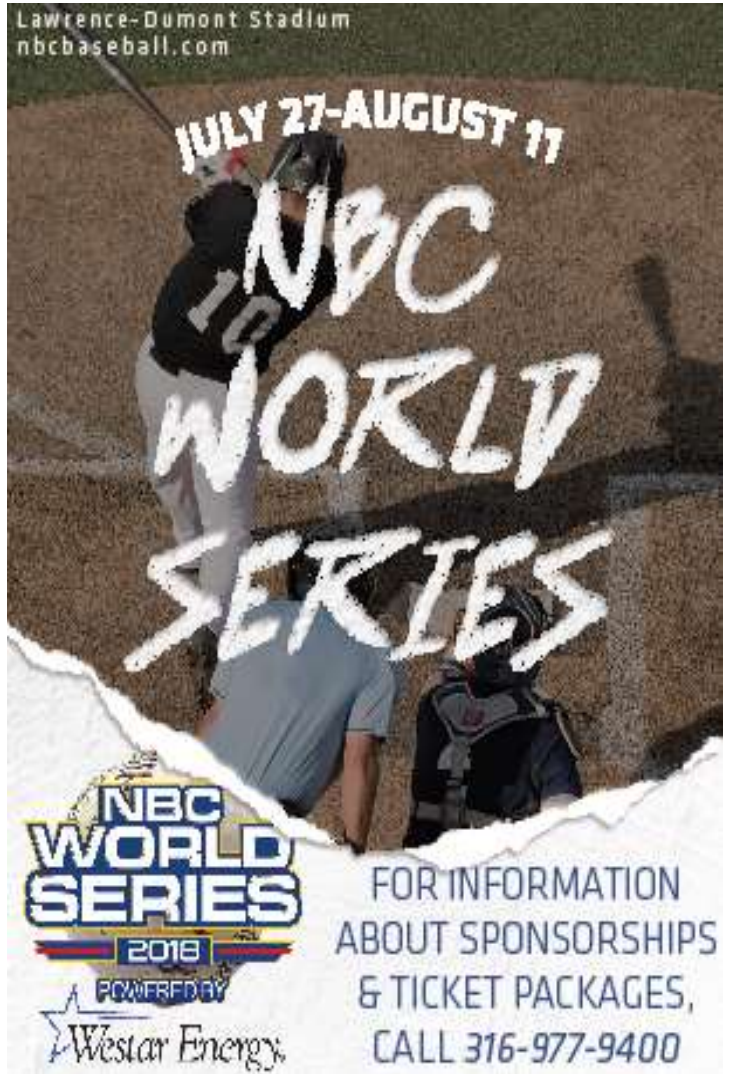
