Bring Animals Inside!

With cold winter temperatures, it is important to remember our four-legged family members. No domesticated animal can withstand being exposed to consistently freezing and below temperatures. Please allow your outside pets to stay in the garage or mud room.

The City of Wichita rules about animal cruelty (Ordinance 6.04.035) require animal custodians to provide adequate shelter, food, water, and health care.

Adequate shelter means a structurally sound, properly ventilated, sanitary and weatherproof shelter suitable for the animal, considering the condition and age of the animal which provides regress from exposure to inclement weather conditions and access to shade from direct sunlight.

Animal Control can be reached at 350-3366 during business hours of 11am - 6:30pm (M-Sa), or after hours at 350-3360. If it's an emergency, dial 911.

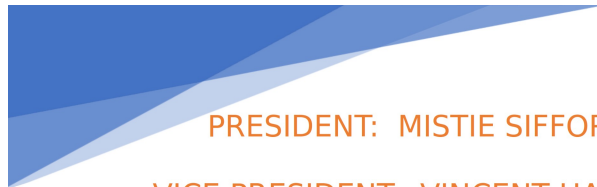
