# Alzheimer's Association Moves To Delano!

The Central and Western Kansas Chapter of The Alzheimer's Association has relocated to Delano, specifically 535 W. Douglas. Look for them just east of the roundabout here in Delano. This office will serve as a home base for the association which serves 69 counties in Kansas. Their volunteers are fully trained and the new office space will allow them a place to receive continuing education.

Alzheimer's is increasing, most people have a family member, or know somebody who does, who are affected by this disease. Education and support will help reduce the sigma surrounding Alzheimer's.

The association has a 24 hours a day, 7 days a week help line at 1.800.272.3900. However this office allows for people to have a place to come into if they need to after scheduling an appointment.

Juliette Bradley, their State Director of Communications, has invited the public to attend an Open House scheduled from 4pm -6pm on Wednesday, November 8. The ribbon cutting ceremony will take place at 4:15pm.

To enhance the communication process the Director can appoint Block Captains within his/her district. The Block Captains should be relied upon to be the ears and eyes of the Director and should assist in facilitating overall communication within their area. Directors and Block Captains can call for meetings within their area of responsibility to enhance proper communication and the solving of specific issues that can only be remedied at the local level."

### **District 4 DAB Meeting**

The next District 4 Advisory Board meeting will be held on Monday, November 6, 2023, at 6:30 pm at Alford Branch Library, 3447 S Meridian. Staff will provide updates from Police, Fire, Library, and Public Works as well as the new City website, a zone change request from SF-5 Single Family Residential to PUD Planned Unit Development, a zone change request from SF-5 to GC General Commercial, a conditional use request to permit a 92-food wireless telecommunications facility, a zone change request from TF-3 to MF-18 to allow for multiple duplexes, and updates on the proposed city tree policy.

#### Amidon Bridge Ribbon Cutting November 1 - 3:00 pm

The City of Wichita is hosting a ribbon cutting to commemorate the opening (ahead of schedule) of the Amidon Bridge at 3pm on the north end of the bridge.

The Amidon Bridge connects 13th and 21st streets over the Arkansas River and is vital to north/south traffic through the area.



# **New Covenant Church**

Life is Messy...We offer Life Support. New Covenant Church is all about offering "life support." And while that will include food, clothing, and job assistance, to name a few, it is all about relationships. When relationships are built, there is opportunity to introduce people to the ultimate Life Support, Jesus Christ!

New Covenant Church is a store front church ... actually *two* store fronts ... located in the Historic Delano District. Pastor Cathy Holley has pastored at New Covenant since 2007, with the firm belief that everyone can have a "new beginning." In July New Covenant became affiliated with the Global Methodist Church.

The Life Support Center houses the missional ministries of New Covenant. Every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon sack lunches are served, clothing distributed, and friends are made. An advocate is on site, offering assistance in getting ID's, Social Security cards, and other life support. The Workbench allows for creativity and the chance to make items to be sold to help raise funds. The Abundant Life Job Center offers job readiness training. The last Tuesday of the month we welcome the Shower Up trailer here for showers, free haircuts, and minor bike repairs by Bike Walk Wichita.

Giving a *hand up*, rather than a *hand out* is an important concept for the Life Support Center. The "Dignity Exchange" has been implemented, allowing for our friends to partner with us in doing some sort of service/work for items from the Clothes Closet, the Cupboard Food Co-op, and other resources. We believe everyone has something of worth to offer! This past April New Covenant received the Waypoint Award from True Charity for making major changes toward effective charity.
